## 1.1.3 Travel & Transportation

#### 1. Arriving in Portugal: thee nearest international airport is Lisbon Airport (LIS)


#### 2. Getting from Lisbon to Setúbal / Troia

- By Public Transport: Take the metro from the airport, then a train (Fertagus) or bus to Setúbal.
   The train journey from Lisbon (e.g., Roma-Areeiro, Entrecampos, Sete Rios stations) to Setúbal is approximately 60 minutes.

  - Lisbon Fertagus (train) schedule to and from Setúbal: https://www.fertagus.pt/pt/horarios/fertagus
  - o We recommend taking the metro and the train and avoiding the bus line.
- **By Car:** Approximately 45-60 minutes drive from Lisbon Airport to Setúbal. Car rental is available at the airport.
- Bus Service: The Portuguese Navy provides two bus services that can be used by attendees.
  - o **From Lisbon Naval Base to Troia**: One bus runs twice a day and can be used by people traveling to/from Setúbal. Attendees using this bus do not have to pay the ferry ticket.
    - LISBON NAVAL BASE → TRÓIA (CEOM):
      - Departure from Lisbon Naval Base (in Almada):
        - 06H20 → Ferry Setúbal Tróia: 07H30. (The bus stops near the ferry terminal in Setúbal at approximately 07H20 to collect personnel)
        - 14H30 → Ferry Setúbal Tróia: 15H30. (The bus stops near the ferry terminal at approximately 15H20)
        - Clarification: The bus departs from the Lisbon Naval Base (Almada), stops near the Setúbal ferry terminal about 10 minutes before ferry departure to pick up personnel, then boards the ferry to Tróia, with the final stop at CEOM. These are the only times the bus collects personnel from Setúbal.
    - TRÓIA (CEOM) → LISBON NAVAL BASE:
      - Departure from CEOM:
        - 10H00 → Ferry Tróia Setúbal: 10H30 (after personnel rotation in CEOM)
        - o 18H15 → Ferry Tróia Setúbal: 18H30 (after last SRL)
        - Olarification: This route follows the same pattern as above in reverse. The bus departs from CEOM, boards the ferry to Setúbal, and continues to Lisbon Naval Base (Almada). Personnel who wish to disembark in Setúbal may do so onboard the ferry before the bus continues to the base. These are the only occasions when the bus travels from Tróia to Setúbal.
  - Navigating to Troia (from Setúbal): There are two main ways to reach the Troia Peninsula from Setúbal.
    - <u>Ferry Service</u> (Car & Passengers Atlantic Ferries):
      - This ferry allows vehicles to cross to Troia. Ideal if you have a rental car.
      - Setúbal Ferry Terminal: <u>link here</u>

- <u>Catamaran Service</u> (Passengers Only Atlantic Ferries):
  - A faster, passenger-only service from Setúbal to Troia Marina.
  - Setúbal Catamaran Terminal: link here

- **Shuttle Service:** Hotel Shuttle Service this is a separate shuttle line running in a loop between hotels and key locations. People traveling to/from Troia by Ferry or Catamaran must pay for the corresponding ticket.
  - Route: CEOM → Editory Hotel → Design Hotel/Catamaran → Aqualuz Hotel → Ferry Terminal (Tróia South) → CEOM
  - Schedule:
    - 08H00 10H00: Bus every 20 minutes
    - 10H00 17H00: Bus every 1 hour
    - 17H00 19H00: Bus every 20 minutes



## 1.1.4 Accommodation Suggestions

We recommend booking your accommodation in **Setúbal**, as it provides convenient access to Hotel Cristal for the conference day and a straightforward connection to Troia for the demonstration.

- **Hotel Cristal Setúbal:** The conference venue itself may offer convenient accommodation. There is a discount code for event participants who choose to stay at the hotel.

#### 1.1.5 Local Recommendations

**Dining in Setúbal:** Setúbal is renowned for its fresh seafood, especially grilled fish and choco frito (fried cuttlefish). Explore the local restaurants around the city center and along the waterfront.

#### Things to Do:

- Visit the Mercado do Livramento (municipal market) in Setúbal.
- Explore the Arrábida Natural Park, known for its stunning beaches and lush hills.
- Take a dolphin-watching tour in the Sado Estuary.
